In order to accommodate at-home learning for those not ready to return to school for traditional instruction, the following guidelines have been put in place. Trimester Commitment

Students who register for the at-home learning option will be committed to that option for one trimester. With one week remaining in the current trimester, a family will decide whether to continue with at-home learning for the following trimester or return to the traditional classroom setting.

Students who register for the at-home learning option once the trimester begins will be committed to that option for the remainder of the trimester. With one week remaining in that current trimester, a family will decide whether to continue with at-home learning or return to the traditional classroom setting.

Families who elect to register their child(ren) for the at-home learning option once the trimester begins must give one week notice to Mrs. Nesmith by completing this form.

Please note that students who choose the at-home learning option may not participate in “in-person” extra-curricular activities sponsored by St. Paul. However, if virtual options are selected for extra-curricular activities, at-home learners will be eligible to participate.

Student/Parent Expectations for At-Home Learning

- Parent(s)/Guardian(s) and student(s) must monitor Google Classroom, Seesaw and/or email communication from teachers to ensure that the student’s work is up to date.
- Dates/Deadlines for student work will still apply.
- Each day teachers will record the instructional portion of each lesson.

- o Students will have access to these recordings via email by 8:00 a.m. the next instructional day.
- o Assignments are due 24 hours after the original due date unless specified by the teacher.
- Parent/Guardian and/or student must communicate promptly with the teacher if any issue prevents satisfactory and prompt completion of assignments.
- Student(s) will attend two virtual meetings per week with the teacher(s) as scheduled by the teacher(s). These sessions will include all students from that grade level who have selected the at-home learning option. The teacher will provide the schedule for these virtual meetings at the onset of the trimester.
- At-Home learners will follow the same academic scale as students in the traditional classroom setting.

Teacher Expectations for At-Home Learning

- Each day teachers will record the instructional portion of each lesson.
 - o Students will have access to these recordings via email by 8:00 a.m. the following instructional day.
 - o Assignments are due 24 hours after the original due date unless specified by the teacher.
 - o Curriculum for at-home learners is the same.
- Teacher(s) will correspond with the family to provide support to the at-home learner, by scheduling two virtual meetings per week. These sessions will include all students from that grade level who have selected the at-home learning option.
- At-home learners will receive timely feedback for submitted assignments. Student grades will be recorded in the same format as for those students who selected in-person instruction.
